

**Transcript of Alexander Donne's Will CRO AP/D/750**

In the name of God Amen I Alexander Donne of St Earth in the County of Cornwall yeoman beeing now of Sound and pfect memory doe hereby make my last Last will and testament in manner and forme Following

First whereas John Donne my Sonne by his deede bearing the date the First day of July One Thousand six hundred sixty and Nine hath covenanted with me the said Alexander Donne that If t[h]e said John Donne shall happen to survive me the said Alexander Donne and Sephronia my wife that then the said John Donne shall and will within six Months next after t[h]e deaths of me t[h]e said Alexander Donne and Sephronia my wife satifie and pay unto my Execut[or]s or Adm[inistrator]s or to such persin or persins whome I the said Alexander Donne by my will or otherwise shall appointe the summe of thirty pounds of good and lawfull money of England as by the said deede more fully will appeere, I doe hereby order and appointe t[h]e said John Donne to pay t[h]e said thirty pounds when the same shall become due unto William Donne Jane t[h]e wife of William Ward Margery Donne Mary<sup>Donne</sup> Grace Donne and Sephronia Donne my sonne and daughters which said Summe of thirty pounds I doe give Betweene them to be equally divided amongst them

And whereby I have heretofore made A provision for my said Sonne John Donne yet in Remembrance of him and of my Love to him I give him Twelve pence to be paid by my Execut[or]s hereafter named

All the Rest of my goods and chattills I give and bequeath unto Sephronia my wife and Arthur Donne my sonne whome I doe hereby make and appointe my whole and sole Execut[or]s of this my Last will and Testament

In witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand and seale this Sixteenth day of Aprill in the yeer of our Lord One thousand and Six Hundred Seventy and Two.
