In the name of god Amen Know yee that I William Dunn of St Earth in y^e C[ounty] of Cornwall yeoman Being weake in bodie but praised bee god of good [and] pfecte Memorie Doe Make this My Last will and Testament in Manner and forme ffollownige; Impr[im]is I Bequeath My Soule to Almighty God that gave itt [and] trust in his Marcie for Salvac[i]on And My body I bequeath to Christian Buriall in the earth from whence itt Came

Imp[rim]is I give and Bequeath to My welbeloved wife Jane Donn All My estate[s] and [R]ight I have in the howse in the Church Towne wherein William Christ[opher] now lives w[ich] I hould by and under the grant of M^r John Priduax Esq @@@@ deceased [and] the M^r Walter Langdon Esq

Item I give and Bequath to My Daughter Christian the wife of ffrancis Rich[ards] the Some of ffortie Shillings to bee paid to hir xij Moneths after my decease And [^] to each of my Sonnes where now livinge I give and Bequeathe five Shillings Appeece to bee paid them when they shall Com to demande itt: All My good[s] and Chattells aswell w[ith]in doares as without I give and Bequeath to My loy[al] wife Jane Bunn Whome I Make My full and whole executrix: This [is my]
